
The white horse was a girl and her name was White Cloud.

The blue horse was a boy and his name was Blue Sky.







I have decided that the peace heart will stand for **COMPASSION.**”



I have decided that my white and brown feather will stand for **COOPERATION.**”





Courage







They broke their trip up into the seven continents that make up the planet Earth - Africa, Asia, Australia, Antarctica, South America, North America, and last would be Europe.

Africa




They did not know what to expect, and were happy when they landed safely in Africa. Oh my, how the children were excited when they saw the four horses coming down from the sky.

Australia




They were surprised that on Earth, children speak many different languages, so the peace heart made a lot of sense because it had all the

North America



Chapter Four



bodies were stronger and our spirits were higher.....all from meeting the children on planet Earth and fulfilling **Project Victory**.


