The 100th Monkey Phenomenon

There is a true and awe inspiring story of the 100th monkey. In 1952, it was documented by researchers that when 100 monkeys on Koshima, a Japanese island started doing something they had never done before, by washing their sweet potatoes, automatically, monkeys from another island, many miles away, started washing their sweet potatoes as well. Also, it was recorded that the first monkey to wash the sweet potato was a young 18 month old monkey. Exercise 1

Numerology

It is very easy to feel confused as to why we are here in this world. Numerology is an ancient knowledge that can help solve the mysteries of our life. It dates back to antiquity and is associated with astrology and alchemy.

The underlying philosophy behind numerology is that we all have our individual life destiny. Therefore, it is best used to discover our personal purpose and strengths, so we know where we need to go and grow. Our life path is found from our birthdate. It is the sum of the day, month and year we are born.

The life path numbers are 1-9. However, there are two exceptions of master numbers, which are 11 and 22.

The following lists the gifts, possible career choices and personal meanings for each number.

How to Calculate Your Life Path Number

Mark down the day you were born. You add all the numbers together and then take it down to a singular number, unless it adds up to an 11 or a 22. An 11 and a 22 remain as an 11 or 22.

Examples:

If you were born on September 21, 2004

$$9/21/2004 = 9+21+2+0+0+4 = 54 \dots\dots 5+4 = \mathbf{9}$$

9 is your birth number

If you were born on July 4, 1998

$$7/4/1998 = 7+4+1+9+9+8 = 38 \dots\dots 3+8 = \mathbf{11} \text{ (11 unreduced)}$$

11 is your birth number

If you were born December 1, 1968

12/1/1968

$$12+1+1+9+6+8 = 37 \dots\dots 3+7 = 10 \dots\dots 1+0 = \mathbf{1}$$

1 is your birth number

If you were born June 25, 1979

6/25/1979

$$6+2+5+1+9+7+9 = 39 \dots\dots 3+9 = 12 \dots\dots 1+2 = \mathbf{3}$$

3 is your birth number

If you were born March 8, 1901

3/8/1901

$$3+8+1+9+0+1 = 22 \dots\dots \mathbf{22} \text{ (unreduced)}$$

22 is your birth number

Meaning of Numbers

Number One

The number 1 represents all the possibilities of opportunity. It is the spark that contains and births new endeavors and expanded horizons. It is a powerful energy that brings the spiritual and physical aspect of the self into being.

Attributes - Original, strong, leader, courageous, daring, instigator, ambitious, independent, positive.

Possible Career - Pioneer, explorer of new ideas, creator, originator, leader, director, manager, chief executive, captain.

Personal Meaning - 1 is a strong assertive symbol of individuality, representing the power within, being at one with oneself. The form of number 1 is straight like an arrow.

Number Two

The number 2 represents the action of integrations and unification to opposing forces. It brings opportunities to blend, integrate, create and expand life's experiences in the physical world.

Attributes - Sweet, soft-spoken, parental, harmonious, loving, comforter, gentle, considerate, charming.

Possible Career - Diplomat, states person, politician, psychologist, teacher, details, artist, home-maker, psychic, medium.

Personal Meaning - 2 is union, the embodiment of partnership. The purpose of cooperation and co-creation. The number 2 focuses on the balance of the male and female.

Number Three

The number 3 represents the creative energy of communication and intellect. It symbolizes and synthesizes growth, cleansing and new beginnings, which harvests happiness, beauty and success

Attributes - Great personality, animated, talkative, popular, loves beauty, joyful, optimistic, kind, friendly.

Possible Career - Artist, entertainer, poet, writer, singer, lecturer, organizer, welfare worker, decorator, clergy person.

Personal Meaning - 3 is positive thoughts activated. The number 3 has an awareness of joining together of mind, body and spirit.

Number Four

The number 4 represents foundations and boundaries. It symbolizes protection, strength, vitality and vision. It holds a sacred space for dreams and visions to be able to manifest through principles and valor.

Attributes - Solid, precise, dignified, dependable, dutiful, pillar of strength, practical, devoted, worthy.

Possible Career - Author, economist, technician, professor, scientist, accountant, skilled crafts person, doctor, electrician.

Personal Meaning - 4 is safety and security of home. The number 4 has a need for stability and values.

Number Five

The number 5 represents transforming worn-out conditioning, thereby moving truth into higher consciousness. It guides us to an awareness of inner wealth in order to find our true purpose.

Attributes - Striking, entertaining, attractive, adventurous, travels through life, versatile, clever.

Possible Career - Lawyer, editor, promoter, salesperson, writer, platform speaker, critic, theatrical director or manager.

Personal Meaning - 5 is free spirited and creative. The number 5 is a doing number representing adventures, exposure to different cultures and action.

Number Six

The number 6 represents harmony, integration, transition and expansion. Its power lies in our intuition and wisdom, which bring high ideals and common sense, leading to a place of peace.

Attributes - Harmonious, good taste, domestic, cosmic comforter, understanding, sympathetic, just.

Possible Career - Artist, doctor, nurse, writer, hotel executive, restaurateur, corporate executive, head of personnel.

Personal Meaning - 6 is the realm of inner vision, inner beauty and inner wisdom. The number 6 opens gateways to imagination and infinite powers.

Number Seven

The number 7 represents victory and success through true alignment and responsible choices. It holds courage, strength and conviction to live our purest values and to be the motivator and generator of such.

Attributes - Poised, refined, unruffled, wise, mystical, trustworthy, introspective, mental capacity.

Possible Career - Judge, lawyer, scientist, banker, inventor, dean or administrator, clergy person, leans towards religion.

Personal Meaning - 7 is intuitive feelings and opens the realm of divine vibration. The number 7 taps into signs and synchronicities.

Number Eight

The number 8 represents the creative rational mind channeling cosmic energy into manifestation. Eights have a deep well of inner wisdom and are called to a higher purpose by taking this knowledge out to the world.

Attributes - Prosperous, discriminative, strong, efficient, powerful, materially inclined, dependable.

Possible Career - Financier, banker, executive, commercial magnate, consultant, promoter, broker, builder, manufacturer.

Personal Meaning - 8 is abundance and prosperity. The number 8 is in alignment with self-empowerment through right actions and right livelihood.

Number Nine

The number 9 represents awakening to the spiritual will and becoming the 'way shower'. It teaches us how to have trust in our hearts and brings abundance by moving us to a higher place of faith and knowing.

Attributes - Courteous, kindly, universal, problem solver, selfless server, breadth of viewpoint, genius.

Possible Career - Healer, preacher, criminal lawyer, doctor, philanthropist, humanitarian, advisor, composer, preacher.

Personal Meaning - 9 is cosmic consciousness. The number 9 opens one to a spiritual blessing of a higher purpose and service.

Number Eleven

The number 11 represents justice, weighing situations and making fair decisions. It balances our intuitive self and spiritual values with our conscious mind and moral integrity. It works with earth, cosmic and karmic laws.

Attributes - Refined, spiritual, vibrant, inspired, faith driven, intuitive, loves revelations, poetic.

Possible Career - Minister, reformer, welfare worker, psychologist, charity worker, explorer, inventor, philosopher, actor.

Personal Meaning - 11 is spiritual mastery. The number 11 is one with peace and harmony through spiritual consciousness.

Number Twenty-Two

The number 22 represents mastery and enlightenment. We become fully integrated, opening up to the boundless gifts of the world. It brings manifestation of the most wondrous, unimaginable miracles of the Universe.

Attributes - Harmonious, energetic, poised, always sees the bigger picture, practical idealism, master.

Possible Career - Builder, Buyer, practical reformer, writer, teacher, involved with large concerns, world affair organizer.

Personal Meaning - 22 is peace, love, happiness, work and prosperity coming true. The number 22 is the master of all masters, able to appeal to the masses.
