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Adonai

Adonai is a Hebrew word that means any manifestation of higher Light consciousness. It represents the representation of the Divine Mind.

Aeon

The word aeon originally meant life, vital force or, being. It could also mean a period of time, though it tended to be translated as an age, or forever, or timeless. or for eternity. Plato used the word to denote the eternal world of ideas, which he believed was behind the perceived. The idea of eternal life comes from a form of aeon.

I AM Movement

The I AM Movement is the original Ascended Master Teachings religious movement, founded in the early 1930s, in Chicago, Ill. It is an offshoot of Theosophy and New Age Religions. The movement believes in the existence of a group called the Ascended Masters, a hierarchy of supernatural beings, who are believed to communicate to humanity through certain trained messengers. It teaches that the Mighty I AM Presence is God existing in each person's higher- self and that by tapping into internalized power and self-purification, one amplifies the expression of virtue, justice, peace, love and harmony. Both Theosophy and the I AM Movement build their beliefs on Jesus's teachings. The I Am Movement has sanctuaries all over the world.

I AM PRESENCE

The I Am presence is the outer expression of the Divine Self in form, as embodied individuals. It is our unique and immortal true identity sharing in the oneness with The Divine. It is the spiritual self, as distinguished from the sensate self. By use of the I Am Presence, we link ourselves with spirit, wisdom, love, peace, strength, and Truth, which dwell within us.

Iao

Iao is a Hebrew/Coptic name for the good attribute of God, which is applied for the unveiling of knowledge, or revelatory insight of "goodness" necessary to work with the divine program.

I Ching

The I Ching is an ancient Chinese divination text and among the oldest of the Chinese Classics. It was published in the late 9th century BC. There are 64 hexagrams, which are simple and profound. It is consulted for its advice and insight into human affairs.

Ideas

An idea is the mode of expression of the mind. The Divine expresses Himself through ideas, which are agents for the divine will, and are the seeds implanted for manifestation.

Image

Graven images of The Divine are made up of mental pictures. Though we may want to see The Divine in our own creative imagination, we must always remember that what is vitally important is to be in touch with the Divine Spirit.

Immeasurable Deep

The immeasurable deep is a definition of things that are unfathomable to the senses, profound beyond understanding and infinite.

Incense

The symbology of burning incense is transmutation. Our nature goes through a refinement and is changed. It is believed that the ritual of burning incense on an altar calls in our celestial body from a radiant dimension.

Incomprehensible

Incomprehensible is having no limits and impossible to understand.

Ineffable

Ineffable is equated to the divine name meaning the Omnipresent Existence of God.

Infinite Way

The infinite Way is a shared planning between the Infinite Mind and the species it is intended for. It is the Way where The Divine's thought forms can be retrieved.

Intellect

Intellect is the understanding of the five-sense human, who judges by appearances and reasons in their limitation. The intellect, because of its limited concepts, cannot grasp the absolute Truth. Intelligence

Intelligence is the ability to acquire and apply knowledge and skill. Where intellect is the faculty of objective reasoning and understanding, intelligence is self-awareness, learning, emotional knowledge, creativity, clever thinking processes and smart problem solving-skills.

Higher Intelligence

Higher Intelligence is an advanced of physical and spiritual intelligence, which administers to inter-planetary civilizations.

Intuition

Intuition is the wisdom of the heart. When one trusts spirit and looks to it for understanding, a certain confidence in the invisible good develops in our soul. This good awakens our faith and our faith awakens our divine knowing intuition.

Kabbalah

The Kabbalah is a tradition which has been received from the Divine. It is the highest interpretation of many worlds. It corresponds to heavenly Knowledge and wisdom that applies to each level of creation. It teaches that the human task is to discover the Holy Sparks within each situation, and to avoid inviting and embracing that which is evil. It is designed so that humans can bring about the spiritual rectification of the world, returning it to the original state of Holiness and unity, that existed before the fall.

Kali Yuga

Kali Yuga in Hindu beliefs is considered the era of darkness. This era began in 3102 BC. Kenosis

Khadga

Khadga is the Buddhist flaming sword that destroys all ignorance.

Kundalini

The kundalini, in Hinduism belief, is a form of feminine energy and consciousness, located at the base of the spine. It is believed to be a powerful force associated with the divine feminine. It is believed, when cultivated, to lead to spiritual liberation. It was adopted in Hatha yoga in the 9th century.

Lamb of God

In Scripture, the Lamb of God is the Divine Life. This carries the symbology of purity, innocence, and guilelessness. Its nature is to give life to all it touches. It knows only to give unceasingly and eternally without restraint.

Law

Logos is the word which originated in thoughts and was thrust by God into the intelligible world. It is the Word of the Supreme, and it contains all potentiality. Everything is a word before it becomes into being.

Love

Love is the attribute of God that is shared with all creations. It explains the desirability of the soul to move from the lower realms into the higher realms. It is the substance of Eternal Life.

Macrocosm

Mandala

Manna

This mystical kingdom of jewel lakes, wish-fulfilling trees and speaking stones has fired the imagination of both actual explorers and people meditating to the inner realms. Others believe that they are a spiritual reality on the etheric plan, expressing the Will of The Divine.

Shekinah

The Jewish people believed that the Tabernacle held the presence of the Shekinah, which is why they traveled with it. The Shekinah is reported as being present when someone is sick, or in need. The color for the Shekinah glory is gold.

They believed that Sirius had a tremendous effect upon life on our planet, so they marked the rise of Sirius as the first day of their calendar year and they built their pyramids in relationship to its position. They also called it the Star of Isis.

Sophia

Sophia means wisdom and is identified with the Holy Spirit. Sophiology is a controversial school of thought, believing that Sophia is to be identified and expressed in the world as Mother-Daughter-Holy Spirit, pairing with the Trinity of Father-Son-Holy Spirit. She is often referred to as 'The Bride of God'.

Soul

Some authors and films have suggested that the Holy Grail is the sang real, meaning the 'royal bloodline of Jesus'.

The Midst

Theosophy

Trinity of Paradise
